On the Easter weekend the Hungarian fellowship hosted the first Spring Camp in three years with the camp theme "Revival Defeats Fear".

With participants from Hungary, Holland, Czech, Austria, Ukraine, Switzerland and the UK, altogether 87 local people and 42 from abroad, this was a wonderful international camp, offering great opportunities to meet and learn from new brothers and sisters and their testimonies and catching up with old ones.

One special thing was a relatively large number of new people and guests participating, including a traveller, who was staying at the campsite when he heard the gospel. He was lost in the world and looking for peace, and at camp got born again and joined our meetings (see photos page 3).

Lots of spiritual food was served in the form of talks, conversations, items and spiritual gifts. The question attached to the camp theme "what will you do about it?" challenges us to do more about revival and more against fear. We heard a presentation on bible prophecy about Russia, we saw God's blessing being asked on our new pastor, Ps. Nigel and saw two baptisms, with three people receiving the gift of the Holy Ghost. There was something to learn and take home from this great camp for everyone, saints received answers, overcame weaknesses and were built up in the Spirit - all according to the glory of our God. 
Editorial: The future.

One day during the autumn camp I had a headache. I refused the program with our sisters in the afternoon but sister Hela took me for prayer.
