"In 2011 I had an open-heart surgery and needed 6 bypasses. Till now everything went well with my heart.


At the end of last month, I had 2 angina pectoris attacks and breathing problems again and again. In addition, I had lots of extra heartbeats (systoles).

I had to do a stress ECG and the result was, that I managed the 100% load without any problems. The cardiologist mentioned that this is rare that someone

reaches it with a heart disease. The Lord was at work already. Only the resting ECG still showed these many extra beats. We continued to pray and after some days, my heartbeat was completely normal, and no further exams are needed. I thank the Lord for everything, and I thank you all for the prayers."




