We had a miracle testimony with our hall. We had to move out in March as the owner would not allow any less rental fee during the Covid lockdown when we could not use it. We have been using other halls since then but started negotiation once again a few months ago with the owner as the new tenants plan to make it a supermarket fell through. We discussed what we could realistically do and stuck to our plan during extended negotiations. The end result is we have the hall for 27% less than we paid before on a five year contract and the work that is needed to be done because the other tenants destroyed the insides will be paid for by the fact that we have the hall for the first three months at a really low price. The brethren have been hard at work making it usable, and we were able to hold our first meeting after a week of solid work. The Hungarian Fellowship








Almere, NL

The church they went to in Ghana told her that she needed to wait until the right age, but she concluded now that this is a situation of life or death, heaven or hell.

Soraya was not feeling well and throughout the whole night she threw up very violently and had so much pain that she couldn't walk at all. We all prayed together with her parents for her healing. Next day she did not feel good enough to go to the bible class first but later on she still wanted to go. She took part in the spiritual gifts during





the bible class meeting and when she came down she did not have any pain anymore in her arms and legs and stopped vomiting. It is wonderful to see that the Lord always answers our prayers in faith.

This month we had a concert night where brethren introduced some new choruses, an evening with short talks, an evening with a presentation of brother

Wout: the night is far spent, the day is at hand. During this night brother Miguel and sister Merlyn from Dordrecht shared their testimonies with us how the Lord turned their night into day. Dordrecht

During one of our Saturday night activities we had a very interesting bible study on eternal life. The promise that we've been given by our God. A sister fell from the stairs at night. She was home alone and her whole body was aching. She prayed and the pain left her. Testimony shared by Lee & Yarni, Liverpool


Hello all! It will take forever to tell everyone personally but we wanted to share some news. We have had a miracle happen and in April 2021 it is expected that we will become parents to "mini-Finney".

Since her late teens, Yarni had 17 years of health difficulties with Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome (PCOS) and Fibroids with all the usual symptoms including infertility. We have been married for 22 years and for 8 of those she endured various fertility treatments by one of the leading hospitals in this field and without success or any hope for the future. Fertility treatment finished in 2012 and we have had no medical intervention since then. This was clearly

Yarni is now 42 and I will turn 50 one month before the baby is due and with everything else considered this is an unexpected miracle for which we give God the glory and hope He will give us the strength and wisdom to become good parents.
