Editorial: Christian and buddhist

(From a local newspaper: Trouw)

At the Vrije Universiteit in Amsterdam, research is being conducted into how religion is changing and transforming. 'People are increasingly drawing inspiration from multiple faiths and seem to have less and less need for religious identification.'

Religion is not disappearing, says André van der Braak. He is professor of comparative philosophy of religion at the Vrije Universiteit in Amsterdam. "People are religious in a different way than they used to be," he says. "They are not limited to one religion, but are inspired by multiple worldviews. They also have less need for religious identification."



Diana Vernooij: "I read stories in the Bible that gave me stepping stones to stand in the world with meekness and strength".

She is a Christian **and** Buddhist, says Diana Vernooij (66). She has been a pastor at de Duif, a Christian faith community in Amsterdam, for thirty years. For her sermons she also draws inspiration from Buddhism. "There are people who claim that I cannot be both Christian and Buddhist. If you don't believe in the father, son, and holy spirit, you wouldn't be a Christian. I've also had a Buddhist teacher who said if you don't believe in reincarnation, you're not a Buddhist. I'm not worried about those dogmas. I see God and Buddha as concepts that I explore and internalize. In my eyes, Buddha and God are active forces or life energies."

So, what's new?

When the Israelites had been in Egypt for approximately 215 years, they left this country around 1446 BC. The Egyptians were glad to see them go... Ex 12:33 And the Egyptians were urgent upon the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste; for they said, We be all dead men.

But...

Ex 12:38 And a <u>mixed multitude</u> went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, even very much cattle. So, when they left, many people left with them who were not really Israelites.

These people, just mixed together with them, became a real problem further on in history. Read...

Nu 11:4 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?

5 We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick:
6 But now our soul is dried away: there is nothing at all, beside this manna, before our eyes.

This principle of mixing the real God and his service with religion is all around us. With what results?



Another well known story is recorded in 1Kings 18. The worship of Baal.

Baal worship took many forms, and the result of this worship is beautifully recorded in...

1Ki 18:28 And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them. 29 And it came to pass, when midday was past, and they prophesied until the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that <u>there was neither</u> <u>voice, nor any to answer, nor any that regarded.</u>

And THAT is what it is all about. All that mixed stuff can sound nice,

but at the end it simply does not work. No signs, wonders and miracles, point out.

We continue to follow up the many contacts made during the weekend. Stay tuned for more news of revival! Revival Fellowship France





Almere

Dordrecht

A brother recently got healed from a burnout. His doctor and his colleagues were amazed at his rapid recovery.

A brother was in great need of money for his living expenses. He prayed about the situation together with a sister. After prayer they walked outside on the streets and there he found 50 euros: the exact amount he needed. God is our provider!

A brother had a heart attack around two and half years ago. During his check up one year later the doctors couldn't find any sign of the heart attack.

France



What an awesome month of September! We had a real international flavour to the month with visitors from the UK and Australia, a Bible study with the saints in Switzerland & Germany, and our annual outreach weekend (see report on page 4). It was wonderful to spend time with Ben and Beth McDonald from the fellowship in Geelong. Ben shared in his testimony how he was a "fellowship baby" although his parents weren't coming along, as young kids he and his siblings used to be

dropped off at the meetings and were really encouraged and brought up in the Lord by their spiritual uncles and aunties. As a teenager he was miraculously healed from an addiction to sport, which would have otherwise taken his life down a very

different track. Beth shared how as a child it was the Gulf War that really motivated her to be born again herself. Hungary

In September we did a major outreach in the country town of Kecskemét which was supported by a great number of brethren. We also held presentations there and later a Wednesday night meeting. An old friend of a sister received the Holy Spirit. A couple recently moved to a new house and decided to have a house-warming party, where some 12 local guests came and many more brethren. Rainy weather did not discourage us, there were conversations about the Lord everywhere and of course lot's of food too. Ps Chris, Monika and Ben visited from Australia. Ps Chris and Monika both celebrated their 50th birthday, including a dinner night where many-many of their relatives and friends heard testimonies and the message of the Lord. Late September we worked a bit on our hall to make it more energy efficient. A brother was protected by God in a car accident where a drunken driver run into several cars including his on the highway with 110Km/h. Several more brethren praise the Lord for protecting them from electric shocks and hurting themselves. A sister used to have cysts and gynaecological problems that caused pain regularly for many years. When

she came to the Lord she prayed about it and this month she realized she's been healed. A young brother praises the Lord for recovering quickly from strained tendons.



I was on a building project in Watford in 1990, working with a group of guys from the Revival Fellowship. One by one, they preached the gospel of salvation to me and answered all my questions about life directly from the Bible.

I attended a Sunday meeting, and after hearing the same clear message preached, I decided to put what I'd heard to the test. That day I repented and was baptised by full immersion in water with the expecta-
